Maida Development Company's Proposition 65 Statement for Metal Oxide Varistor Products

Proposition 65, officially known as the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986, was enacted as a ballot initiative in November 1986. The proposition protects the state of California's drinking water sources from being contaminated with chemicals known to cause cancer, birth defects or other reproductive harm, and requires businesses to inform Californians about exposures to such chemicals.

The list of chemicals is updated annually and using its knowledge of its business operations and the chemicals it uses, a business can review the Proposition 65 list to determine whether its operations or products are likely to expose people in California to any listed chemicals. Depending on the level of exposure, the business may be required to provide a warning for those exposures.

Maida Development has performed a review of the operations and has determined there is no risk of exposure for Californians to the listed chemicals in Proposition 65.
